Panhandle Alliance for Education advocates for quality education in the Lake Pend Oreille School District and is a leader among community education foundations throughout the state and region.


PAFE envisions a community where every child can realize their full potential, supported by engaged families, inspired educators, and a community that values education as a cornerstone of prosperity.

As an independent organization, we create and sustain an endowment to provide resources in support of effective teaching, learning, and school management.




METHODOLOGY A collective effort...

This strategic plan is a collective effort that reflects the feedback of our school district leadership, top donors, emeritus board, and community.

Prior to a two-day facilitated planning workshop in January 2025, the research phase began in October 2024 with focus groups (60 people) and surveys (114 respondents). A briefing report and an information package were prepared and sent to attendees (22 PAFE board members) of the two-day strategic planning workshop facilitated by Dr. Rebecca Sutherns on Jan 13 - 14, 2025. This thorough process ensured that our strategic plan is well-informed and comprehensive.

This plan was authored by Rebecca Sutherns and Lisa Gerber and refined by the steering committee consisting of Amy Longanecker, Kendon Perry, Kelly Prior, and Chris Blanford.



Decision Framework

The group agreed on three guiding principles for this plan:



Everything PAFE does should have a measurable impact. It should also meet a need without increasing the district's administrative burden.

The ideas for all PAFE programs and initiatives are district and educator-led. We rely on the experts to understand what gaps need to be filled. PAFE operates beyond simply writing checks to the District. We strategically fund programs that fill critical academic gaps and enhance facilities.

This approach creates a vital feedback loop demonstrating to donors how their contributions are intentionally and impactfully spent—a crucial element in our fundraising success. By defining our implementation role carefully, we maximize impact while respecting the district's expertise and avoiding additional administrative burden.

1. Increase investment in students' readiness to learn

For students to learn, they must be physically and emotionally prepared, feel safe and nourished, and have a positive physical learning environment. Dated facilities impact classroom size and hinder modern, state-of-the-art learning. When some students are equipped to learn and others are challenged, the entire classroom is affected.

With PAFE helping to address this challenge, students will be set up for success.



For the short term, LPOSD is safe thanks to the indefinite term levy, a long-term tax commitment, but it is predicted we'll need an additional bond or levy in November 2027. Also, school vouchers and opponents of quality education threaten funding.
